

WASTE MANAGEMENT AND ENERGY CONSERVATION




The KLE Academy of Higher Education and Research, Deemed-to-be-University, Belagavi, Karnataka has 10 constituent units under its ambit which include five off-campus centres two at Belagavi, two at Hubballi andone at Bengaluru.

Five constituent colleges are housed in a 110 acres sprawling, beautiful, clean and green campus. All the buildings are an example of modern architecture, its convention centre with four auditoriums is comparable to best anywhere in the world. The University provides excellent facilities for extra-curricular and co-curricular activities in the form of huge amphitheatre, olympic size swimming pool, modern gymnasium, wood floored badminton courts, sports arena, stadium, tennis courts, etc. The campus is well-maintained with lot of greenery. The University garden is a wonderful relaxing place with water bodies and musical fountain.

The infrastructure and facilities for waste management and energy conservation are given below:

WATER TREATMENT PLANT



In order to meet huge requirements of water for drinking and domestic purposes, water treatment plant is set up in the campus. The raw water is treated in this plant and then supplied to the campus. The capacity of the plant is 22.50 lakh LPD. The main sources of water are Hidkal Water Reservoir, Community water harvest source from Lingaraj Campus well, Kangrali B.K. well, in addition to borewell in the campus. Only after testing the water on daily basis, water is supplied for use. Water


treatment is necessary to maintain pH & other parameters as per IS specifications for potability and good health of consumers. 24x7 water supply is ensured in the campus

Rainwater Harvesting

Rainwater harvesting is an innovative technique adopted to harvest the rainwater from roofs. The campus soil strata is 4'-0" below containing impervious and rocky. Hence, the excess rainwater of the campus overflows and collected at lower portion at Kangrali B. K. campus which in turn is collected at open well. The rain water from roof top of the campus buildings is collected in storage tanks, and will be reutilized for gardening and other non-drinking purposes. This technique will help to increase the ground water level and to recharge the bore wells. Rain water harvesting also reduces the soil erosion and pollution of water bodies.

Ecological Benefits:

The ecological benefits of rainwater harvesting are immense. The collected rainwater can be used for various purposes in and around the campus. This includes domestic and gardening and












SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT

The main objective of establishment of Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) is to recycle the waste water and reutilize the same for non-drinking purposes. The waste water generated from the Colleges, Hostels and Staff quarters is let into the campus STP. There are two STP plants of 2000 KLD i.e.1000 KLD each (In College Campus and Hospital campus). The STP is operated by skilled technical staff and also testing of recycled water is done at regular intervals to ensure quality of the water, as per the Pollution Control Board norms. The analysis report of the treated waste water the water is sent to KSPCB monthly. The treated waste water is used for Campus gardening and toilet flushing purposes. The output of recycled water is 2.25 lakh LPD. During the rainy season, the excess treated waste water let out in the municipal UGD and RWH pits.









BIO - DIGESTER TOILETS

Bio-digester technology is a unique innovation in the world of sanitation. It consists of a Bio-toilet attached with bio-digester tanks, where the human faecal matter gets 100% degraded and gets converted into reusable water & bio-gas. The Water is used for watering the plants





Incinerator For Bio-medical Waste Treatment

The Bio-medical waste generated from the Hospital will be collected in closed container trolleys, segregated on site as per the standard norms and disposed in Double Chambered Incinerator Plant, Primary Chamber temperature 800°-850°C and Secondary chamber temperature 1000°- 1100°C. The Capacity of Incinerator is 150° Kg/ hour. Having plastic and paper shredders of capacity 50 kg per hour and 20 kg per hour respectively, used for shredding and waste generated is sent for authorized recyclers. "The Unique feature of incinerator plant is heat recovery unit in flue gas path "which recovers flue gas heat and generate hot water 2000ltrs per hour which is used for boiler feed water, which reduces fuel consumption 5000ltrs per month, approximately.

Steps in the management of hospital waste include

Generation, Segregation / separation, Collection, Transportation, storage Treatment, Final disposal

General Waste: Paper waste, hard boards, cartons, kitchen waste:

- White bin/White bag
- Treatment: Sending to authorized vendor

Kitchen waste sent to vermicompost unit / municipality

<u>Infectious waste</u>: Body parts, placenta, human tissue, surgical waste, cotton, bandages, dressings, solid plaster, beddings, pads, Gauge etc...

- Yellow bin/Yellow bag
- **Treatment**: Incineration

<u>Infectious and non infectious plastic waste:</u> IV Bottles, IV Tubes, Catheters, syringes, gloves, Ryles tube Red bin/Red bag

Treatment: Shredding & Sending to authorized vendor **Sharps**: Puncture proof container, Transparent container

• **Treatment:** Incineration

Glass waste (Ample ,vials and other glass materials)

- Blue bin/Blue Bag
- **Treatment**: Sending to authorized vendor



VERMICOMPOST

Eco-friendly Waste Management Through Vermicomposting:

There are two Vermicompost units installed in University campus and in Ayurveda College campus. The waste generated like dried leaves, garden trimmings, trimmed lawns, etc. in the JNMC campus (Hostel, Garden) are effectively recycled and reutilized by using vermicomposting techniques and converted into quality vermicompost and vermiwash. Two promising worms namely Eudriluseuginiae and Eriseniafoetida are used for vermicompost production.

The total annual production from both the compost units is 20,190 kg and the vermicompost generated is utilized for campus gardening.

Benefits:

- ➤ Vermicompost enhances the growth of the plants and suppresses the diseases in the plants.
- ➤ It improves soil structure, texture, porosity and water holding capacity.
- ➤ It helps to neutralize the pH of the soil.
- Vermicompost enhances the soil and microbial activity.
- ➤ It contains several micro and macro nutrients, vitamins, enzymes and hormones like auxins and gibberellins.













VERMIWASH

Vermiwash is a brown colored liquid fertilizer. It contains large amount of macro and micronutrients, Plant hormones and ensure healthy development of crops. It is mainly used as a foliar spray for crops.





Solid Waste:

The solid waste generated is collected door to door and segregated at source as Bio- Degradable & Non-Bio degradable waste. The Bio-degradable waste is converted into Compost in our on-site Vermi Compost unit and the converted manure is used in our gardens. The Non-Bio degradable waste is segregated into Recyclable & Non-Recyclable waste. The Recyclable waste is handed over to Authorized waste recycler. The Non-Recyclable Non- Biodegradable waste is sent to our Hospital Incinerator. The wet waste like shredded leaves, kitchen waste, hostel food waste is collected door to door and sent for decomposition in our on-site Vermi compost unit for production of manure.



Liquid waste

Liquid Bio-Medical waste is disinfected with 1% of hypochlorite solution. Stationary liquid waste disinfection units are provided at outlet of laboratories in the campus as per the water Act of KSPCB. Treated out let Bio-medical Liquid waste is connected to STP for further treatment.



Bee - Keeping:

Bees are one of the main insects in the world that can produce honey that is beneficial to all of us. We obtain honey from these bee keeping units. Honey is an important food for human beings. Since ancient times, honey is used for treating several diseases and it is an antioxidant. Therefore, beekeeping is an important activity undertaken at the campus and the honey produced at various units is provided to staff of KAHER.





Importance of Bee-keeping:

- 1. Plays an excellent role in pollination. Honey bees are the best pollinating agents which help in increasing the yield of several crops.
- 2. Provides honey which is the most valuable nutritional food.
- 3. Provides bee wax which is used in many industries including cosmetic industries, polishing industries, pharmaceutical industries, etc.

RENEWABLE ENERGY

In order to reduce dependency on HESCOM (Hubbli Electricity Supply Company), to conserve energy, to reduce carbon footprint and to encourage renewable energy usage, compus has got a electrical supply from (i) Wheeling (transportation of electrical energy) from solar power plant situated at Albala village Jamkhandi Taluka, Vijayapur Districts wind power plant at Vijaypur. Solar water heating panels are also provided on staff quarters, hostel roof tops, college building top (work under progress). With alternate source of energy, the dependancy on HESCOM has been reduced by 86%.



Battery Vehicles:

The campus is vehicle free zone. For transportation within the campus, electrical battery vehicles are provided for the staff and students.









SANITARY NAPKIN DISPOSER





Sanitary Napkin Disposers (Incinerator) are fixed in Girls Hostels and the menial staff collect napkins and dispose the same in the incinerator. Sanitary napkin incinerator is used for instant disposal of used napkins. It is specially designed to destroy used napkins. It is the best solution for destroying sanitary napkin and converting it to ash.

Toilet Facility for Differently abled persons:

Toilet facilities are provided at Colleges and Hostels as per the norms. Ramp with railing facility and special provision for parking the vehicles is also provided with demarcation.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AUTHORISATION

- The applicant shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there under.
- 2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the prescribed authority.
- The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the biomedical wastes without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
- Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
- It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
- Applicant shall take all necessary steps to ensure that bio-medical waste is handled without
 any adverse effect to human health and the environment and in accordance with these
 rules.
- Applicant shall make a provision within the premises for a safe, ventilated and secured location for storage of segregated biomedical waste in colored bags or containers in the manner as specified in Schedule I of the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 8. Applicant shall ensure that there shall be no secondary handling, pilferage of recyclables or inadvertent scattering or spillage by animals and the bio-medical waste from such place or premises shall be directly transported in the manner as prescribed in these rules to the common bio-medical waste treatment facility or for the appropriate treatment and disposal, as the case may be, in the manner as prescribed in Schedule I the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- Applicant shall pre-treat the laboratory waste, microbiological waste, blood samples and blood bags through disinfection or sterilisation on-site in the manner as prescribed by the World Health Organisation (WHO) or National AIDs Control Organisation (NACO) guidelines and then sent to the common bio-medical waste treatment facility for final disposal;
- Applicant shall phase out use of chlorinated plastic bags, gloves and blood bags within two years from the date of notification of these rules;
- 11. Applicant shall dispose solid waste other than bio-medical waste in accordance with the provisions of respective waste management rules made under the relevant laws and amended from time to time;
- 12. Applicant shall not to give treated bio-medical waste with municipal solid waste;
- 13. Applicant shall provide training to all its health care workers and others, involved in handling of bio medical waste at the time of induction and thereafter at least once every year and the details of training programmes conducted, number of personnel trained and number of personnel not undergone any training shall be provided in the Annual Report;

(Waste Management Cell)

- 14. Applicant shall immunise all its health care workers and others, involved in handling of biomedical waste for protection against diseases including Hepatitis B and Tetanus that are likely to be transmitted by handling of bio-medical waste, in the manner as prescribed in the National Immunisation Policy or the guidelines of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare issued from time to time;
- 15. Applicant shall establish a Bar- Code System for bags or containing bio-medical waste to be sent out of the premises or place for any purpose;
- 16. Applicant shall ensure segregation of liquid chemical waste at source and ensure pretreatment or neutralisation prior to mixing with other effluent generated from health care facilities.
- 17. Applicant shall ensure treatment and disposal of liquid waste in accordance with the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 (6 of 1974);
- Applicant shall ensure occupational safety of all its health care workers and others involved in handling of biomedical waste by providing appropriate and adequate personal protective equipments;
- 19. Applicant shall conduct health check up at the time of induction and at least once in a year for all its health care workers and others involved in handling of bio- medical waste and maintain the records for the same;
- 20. Applicant shall maintain and update on day to day basis the bio-medical waste management register and display the monthly record on its website according to the bio-medical waste generated in terms of category and colour coding as specified in Schedule I the Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016;
- 21. Applicant shall report major accidents including accidents caused by fire hazards, blasts during handling of biomedical waste and the remedial action taken and the records relevant thereto, (including nil report) in Form I to the prescribed authority and also along with the annual report;
- 22. Applicant shall make available the annual report on its web-site and all the health care facilities.
- 23. Applicant shall inform the prescribed authority immediately in case the operator of a facility does not collect the bio-medical waste within the intended time or as per the agreed time;
- 24. Applicant shall establish a system to review and monitor the activities related to bio-medical waste management, either through an existing committee or by forming a new committee and the Committee shall meet once in every six months and the record of the minutes of the meetings of this committee shall be submitted along with the annual report to the prescribed authority and the healthcare establishments having less than thirty beds shall designate a qualified person to review and monitor the activities relating to bio-medical waste management within that establishment and submit the annual report;
- 25. Applicant shall maintain all record for disposal of biomedical waste for a period of five years.
- 26. The applicant shall immediately adopt bar coding system for Bio medical waste
- 27. The applicant shall update COVID Bio Medical Waste data in CPCB tracking software at bmw.cpcbccr.com/#/p/login.
