1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the Institution :

Following activities were carried out by the University and its constituent units to accomplish the goals and objectives of the University:

- The University started eight new academic programs : M.Ch. (Paediatric Surgery), M.Ch. (Neuro Surgery), D.M. (Cardiac Anaesthesia), MPT in Obstetrics and Gynecology in the faculty of Medicine, M.Pharm. in Pharmaceutics in the faculty of Pharmacy, PG certificate course in Panchakarma, PG certificate course in Ayurvedic Dietics , PG certificate course in Ksharsutra Chikitsa, in the faculty of Ayurveda.
- NAAC sponsored National Seminar on “Quality Assurance in Health Science Institutions” was conducted on the 2nd and 3rd January 2012.

- Establishment of Central Research Facility (CRF) approved by AYUSH for ASU drug testing at KLE Sri BMK Ayurveda Mahavidhyalaya, Belgaum.
- Submission of Proposal to UGC for establishment of Academic Staff College for Health Professionals of the University.
- Health care facilities are further strengthened, as the University has adopted 3 Urban Health Centers in Belgaum under J. N. Medical College, from Government of Karnataka.
- The University and its eight constituent units have conducted Seminars / Workshops / Lecture Series and other curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities, round the year.
- The faculty members and the research scholars are encouraged to conduct research and publish the scientific articles by granting them cash incentives for the same.
- 21 MOUs have been signed by the constituent colleges of the University with various Academic / Research Organizations /Institutions.

3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction :

- Information Communication Technology (ICT) and skill laboratory are utilized for effective teaching of UG & PG students.
- Conducting PG preliminary examinations on the lines of the University Examination

- Seminars and Scientific projects for Fast Learners.
- Mock examinations (of clinical exercises) conducted for PG students.
- The University has performed the periodic revision of curricula / syllabi of 10 UG and 9 PG programs as per the new norms of respective regulating council, which were defined in the year 2008 (3 years back) based on the recommendations of the respective Boards of Studies & approval of the Academic Council.
- Objective Structured Clinical Evaluation (OSCE) / Objective Structured Practical Evaluation (OSPE) have been introduced for internal assessment of various programs.
- Item analysis and Validation of MCQ's is in progress.

4. Inter-disciplinary programmes started :

Ph.D Programs in Inter-disciplinary Research are continued.

5. Examinations reforms implemented :

The University has implemented the following Examinations Reforms:

- Entrance examination has been introduced as per UGC 2009 guidelines for Ph.D Scholars admissions. The Scholars have to pass in the Pre-Ph.D Examination at the end of 1st year after undergoing 6 months of intensive training in Basic Sciences, Statistics, Research Methodology and Specialty papers.
- Ph.D guides are being allotted by the University during the interview of the Ph.D Scholars.
- Feedback obtained from the candidates during each examination are analysed, evaluated and suggestions implemented after discussion and approval in advisory committee of the examinations.
- Feedbacks are obtained from the external examiners during the University Annual Examinations which are further analysed and the worthy ones are implemented for quality improvement of the examinations.

6. Candidates qualify: NET/SLET/GATE etc.

The total number of candidates qualified in Graduate Pharmacy Aptitude Test (GPAT) is 16.

7. Initiative towards faculty development programme :

The University Department of Education for Health Professionals (UDEHP) is a fully functional and an active department. The Department is committed to professional / Faculty development of all the health science faculty. The Department has conducted 18 workshops / programs for the faculty development during the year 2011-12. The total number of faculty

who have been benefited from these activities are 581 out of which 219 are external faculty (from outside institutions) and 362 are internal faculty. In addition the faculty members are also encouraged to attend advanced faculty training programs, at various other Institutions of national / international repute, elsewhere.

UDEHP has organized an “International Conference, on Research and Training in Health Professions Education” (ICONRIPE) on 18th and 19th February 2012, preceded by two pre-conference workshops on 17th to 19th February 2012. A total of 274 delegates participated in the conference. There were 7 international, 3 national and 3 local Resource Persons who shared their valuable knowledge and skills in the field of Health Science Education, with all the participants through Oration, guest lectures, symposia and panel discussions.

IQAC of the University has organized NAAC sponsored National Seminar on “Quality Assurance in Health Science Institutions” on 2nd and 3rd January 2012. A total of 121 delegates from Karnataka, Maharashtra and Goa participated in the same. Prof. H. A. Ranganath, Director of NAAC delivered Inaugural Address, Dr. Chandrashekhhar Shetty, Hon. Vice-Chancellor of Sri Devaraj Urs Deemed University delivered Key Note Address on “Quality Issues Relevant to Health Science Institutions”.

8. Total number of seminars/workshops/CME/Guest Lecture conducted :

A total number of 161 Seminars / Workshops/CME/Guest Lecture were conducted by various Departments of the eight constituent units of the University and UDEHP. **Annexure I - A**

The University has instituted University Guest Lecture Series wherein eminent personalities of National / International repute are invited to deliver the guest lectures. Till date 38 guest lectures have been conducted, out of which 4 have been conducted during the last one year. 5th “KLE University Foundation Day Oration” was delivered by Dr. Shrinivas Saidapur, Former Vice-Chancellor, Karnatak University on 13th April 2011 on the eve of 5th Foundation Day Celebrations. **Annexure I – B**

23. Courses in which student assessment of teachers is introduced and the action taken on student feedback :

- The feedback collected from UG and PG students about teaching faculty is analyzed by the IQAC of the institution.
- Students Feedback about the teachers is taken on a standardized proforma both for theory and practical classes for all the courses at a regular intervals. The feedback is analysed using SPSS software and the student rating of the teachers is calculated on a scale of 100. Those teachers who have less than 80% score are informed by the Principal through the Head of the Department, and are counseled to improve their quality of teaching in specific parameters.

24. Feedback from stakeholders:

Feedback is being obtained from stakeholders (students, parents, external experts, etc.) and appropriate action is being taken to implement the suggestions / inputs obtained.

- Feedback from parents is obtained during the parent-teacher association meeting which is held once in a year. In these meeting discussions regarding students, academic, hostel and extracurricular problems are discussed and necessary solutions are suggested.
- The progress reports of the students are regularly sent to parents after each sessional examination along with feedback form. The feedbacks obtained are analyzed and appropriate action is initiated to implement the suggestions / inputs.

- Biometric analyses and photo identification of the candidates is done during the writing of examination and verification of the same during the counseling process.

- The candidates are admitted based on their inter-se-merit.
- The processes of entry of marks, generation of result sheets, generation of marks cards and provisional degree certificates etc. are totally computerized.
- The Statement of Marks and Convocation Certificates are printed with unique security features and are issued to the students at the end of the examinations and during the Annual Convocation of the University respectively.

27. Increase in the infrastructural facilities :

The creation of infrastructural facilities including construction of new building, renovation of existing structures, procurement of equipments, etc. are being taken up in the constituent units of the University, based on the needs and requirements of the respective Regulating Councils, as per budgetary requirements.

- Three Urban Health Centres – viz. Ashok Nagar, Ram Nagar and Rukmini Nagar of Belgaum have been handed over to the J.N. Medical College under ‘Arogya Bandhu Scheme’ by Government of Karnataka.
- New equipments for laboratory investigation services have been procured in the hospital.

- Renovation of Museums, Laboratories, O.T. etc. of various departments has been carried out during the year.
- Fully equipped Council Hall, New PG blocks, HOD & Staff chambers etc. have been constructed / renovated in various colleges.
- New separate block for Institute of Physiotherapy of 27000 Sq.ft has been constructed.
- Construction of State-of-art Convention Centre and swimming pool is in progress.

28. Technology Up gradation :

- The Journal of the JNMC Scientific Society has its own website with software for editorial management. The papers for publication can be uploaded by the authors and can be tracked. The review process also is online.
- Total Wi-Fi solution to the campus.
- Sophisticated high-end Blade Server has been established which subserves the function of web server, mail server and file server to cater to the needs of all staff and students in the campus.
- Students can access the lecture material available in the University Server.

- 200 new computers have been procured for all the constituent units of the University.
- 50 new laptops have been procured by the University for its constituent units.

29. Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students :

- All the Constituent Units of the University have computers and laptops with internet/intranet facilities for staff and students access.
- The University offers computer training periodically to all the staff (Teaching and Non-teaching), and students about internet accessibility and computer operations usage.

- Monthly stipend is given to Interns & Post Graduate students of Medical & Dental colleges.
- Financial Assistance is provided to students for academic and extra curricular achievements.

31. Activities and support from the Alumni Association :

- Regular registration and updation of the Alumni members is done.
