- 1) **The physical presence of the candidate at the counseling is mandatory.** Candidates should register their names in the attendance register kept at the venue for admission process. The seats will be allotted **only on the inter-se merit among the registered candidates.**
- 2) The candidates registering after **11.30 AM of 15-05-2022** will **not** be considered for counseling.
- 3) Candidates attending counseling should satisfy the eligibility requirement as per the NEET Information Brochure – 2021 / MCC and the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed by the DCI Regulations for admission to Dental courses respectively.
- 4) **Please note that that candidates should come along with original documents as per ANNEXURE-I along with the prescribed fee in the form of Demand Draft/RTGS/NEFT as detailed on the website without which admission will not be given.**
