2. Discussion regarding developing the competency based Curricular changes for 25% of the curriculum

As BPH curriculum is due for revision, they have decided to go for Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), accordingly detailed curriculum was discussed, with difference between old and new curriculum in the form of summary sheet (Annexure)

For few topics Competencies will be identified, objectives will be developed, based on objectives T_L and assessment will be planned. Student's & faculty feedback will I be collected to sustain the implementation.

Any change in the curriculum – Done using Kern's 6 step approach and same has to be presented as summary sheet as per the format given.

Those courses which are due for curriculum changes in next BoS meeting (MHA etc) to come prepared for the BoS to present the changes as per the format

- 3. Strengthening the curriculum by effective implementation of curricular changes It was discussed to implement the curricular changes effectively through periodic review and also by incorporating feedback mechanism.
- 4. Innovative / Best practices to be incorporated in the curriculum also taking inputs from external members External member Dr. Kalpana C.J opined that Diet & Nutrition department can contribute to all the clinical departments in planning the diet for inpatients. So that hands on training will be given to the students and all the departments will be benefited by getting expert guidance to improve nutritional status of patients.
- Preparation of comprehensive panel of examiners for UG, PG and PhD guides as per University norms.

All the departments were sensitized to update the examiner list as per University guidelines. External members opined that a list of eligible examiners could be collected at the departmental level with all the details and renewed every 6 months. All the members felt that, it is difficult to get bank details of all the examiners, as some times there may be merger of banks or change of bank by the examiners etc. It can be procured along with acceptance letter.

6. Discussion regarding feedback mechanism

MHA – Exit feedback was taken – accordingly students expressed lack of infrastructure made it difficult for the students to study properly Also students expressed hands on training in NABH very essential - This has been incorporated and training has been provided at KLE Hospital by Dr. Somanatti.

Department of Public Health – Collected student's feedback – Deficiency of classroom as they are starting with Bachelor degree in nutrition and dietetics, BPH honours etc along with BPH and MPH and common room where students can carryout cocurricular activities/ Study purpose

Dr. Mubashir opined that Hospital Administration and Public Health Department can share common room

7. Any other matter to improve the growth and development of the department

Dr. Nagnoor opined that MPH students to be involved in practical work in the field than in the classroom 60:40 ratio. MHA students already 60% Hospital and 40 %classroom is been practiced.

Dr. Sonali Palkar opined that MPH/ BPH students can mobilise / motivate public to attend camp or vaccination, not to involve them to give vaccination even though their basic degree being BAMS, BHMS. Because designated nurses who are expert to carry vaccination in the field can handle situation better in case of any AEFI (adverse events)

Dr. Shaila Kothiwale opined that MHA students could be posted to Dental College Hospital also to Dental College Hospital - To study the management of Hospitals on OPD basis and to study the Inventory of Drugs / Dental materials

Guide lines from UGC on Semester System, Choice Base Credit System (CBCS) Curriculum Development, Examination Reforms and Grade Point Assessment were studied. The need of the hour is to change from traditional information based knowledge to a more holistic approach providing value based education integrating with special skills and training. MPH program at KLEU has already initiated semester system since 2013. Now MPH program needs to implement Grade Point Assessment System and Choice Base Credit System (CBCS) in its curricula from the academic Year 2015-16. Various Marks Cards from Manipal University, Pune University, SRM

University, Datta Meghe University and Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University were studied.



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WHO Manual for Teaching Guidelines for Public Health Schools in South East Asia Region was also referred to revise the subjects being offered in MPH Program.

After elaborate discussion and deliberations, the following was Proposed:

- Each semester shall be of 25 credits. Therefore MPH will have a total of 100 credits. One credit is equivalent to 15 clock hours of teacher-student contact in a semester (as per UGC norms).
- To have each semester of 25 credits, subjects will be reshuffled in 4 semesters according to the number of teaching hours and credits assigned to each subject (WHO Mannual).

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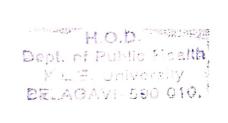
