"RAGGING IS BANNED IN THE INSTITUTION"

An act of ragging shall be liable for punishment, which could include :

- Expulsion from the Institution / College /Hostel / Mess.
- Suspension from the Classes.
- Fine, with a public apoldgy.
- Debarring from representation in events (cultural/sports or any other events for which he/she may have been chosen).
- With holding results.
- Reporting to the police authorities, at the time of admission / enrolment to the college/institution.
- Printed undertaking is to be given by the candidates every year themselves in their own handwriting and by their parents / guardians / caretakers towards ragging and the punishments to which he / she shall be liable if found guilty
- A high level discipline and anti ragging committee keeps continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent the hatching of conspiracy, occurrence and recurrence.
- It can summarily punish / reprimand the guilt, either by itself or by following procedures, administrative or otherwise constituting a special enquiry committee and putting forth its finding and recommendation / suggestion before the authority competent to take decision or to the university.
- Surprise visits are made to the hostels to confirm the safety of the fresher's.
- Banners and placards depicting the ill effects of Ragging and the punishment given to students who indulge in this are displayed at various places in the campus.

PRINCIPAL

IMPORTANT POINTS

1. What is counseling?

Counseling is a one to one interaction between the student and the student counselor whereby the counselor puts the student at ease and tries to understand the problem faced by the student.

"Counseling- strong attempt to establish apositive rapport"

2. What is the difference between a counselor and a psychiatrist?

A psychiatrist is a qualified professional in psychiatry authorized to prescribe medication in cases of major ailments. A counselor is a qualified therapist who spends adequate time to understand the student's problems, get an insight into the student's mind and in turn help the student solve his/her problems. This process involves no medication, only pure interaction.

"Counselor is a qualified therapist, involves no medication, only pure interaction"

3. When / where can I meet the institute's student counselor?

You can meet the counselor on all working days with a prior appointment.

"Prior appointment"

4. Do I have to pay for a visit to the counselor?

No, you do not have to pay anything for this service which is provided by the institute.

5. When should I consider visiting a counselor?

If at any point of time you feel uncomfortable about anything and are unable to carry out your daily activities, you should visit the counselor.

"If problem, Do not spend time thinking, do not try to diagnose personally"

6. How can a counselor help me?

"Counselor will counsel your problems at a personal level or at academic level"

7. Asking for counseling doesn't mean admitting failure?

It is in fact a step ahead in solving a problem and reaching your goal. Likewise, a counselor will help you overcome all your difficulties and keep failure at bay.

"Step ahead in solving your problem and reaching your goal"

8. Will my identity/problem be revealed to the authorities if I meet the counselor?

Under all circumstances, confidentiality is strictly respected. No records are kept of cases too.

"Counselor as a friend, have confidence"

9. How can I figure out if any of my friends needs counseling?

If you find your friend having the following symptoms you may refer him to the student mentor from your hostel - abrupt mood swings, extremely irregular attendance, drastically dismal academic performance, tendency to keep aloof from friends and/or family etc.

"Your name won't be revealed"

10. What can I do if I feel my triend needs the counselor's help?

Contact any mentor coordinator in the Institute. He will report it to the counselor, arrange for a meeting with he/she and provide help to your friend.

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
