Adverse drug reactions (ADRs) remain a significant global cause of death, with over 100,000 reported annual fatalities (Alomar, 2014). The most severe type, type B unpredictable reactions, occur infrequently, are not dose-dependent, and often involve individuals with genetic predispositions (Pirmohamed et al., 2004; Uetrecht, 2007). These reactions can lead to skin or liver injuries, ranging from mild cases like MPE to life-threatening conditions such as DRESS, SJS, and TEN


In this review, we provide an overview of the genetic markers associated with severe adverse drug reactions (ADRs). Our emphasis is on genetic variations in human leukocyte antigens (HLA), T cell receptors (TCR), drug-metabolizing enzymes, and drug transporters. It's noteworthy that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has linked genetic factors to over 180 approved drugs.

Implementation of Pharmacogenomic **Testing in Clinical Practice**

- Genetic patterns linked to HLA genes play a role in severe adverse drug reactions (SCAR) and drug-induced liver injury (DILI) for various drugs. Pharmacogenetic markers are effective in practice. Cost-effectiveness studies support genetic testing before drug treatment to prevent SCAR, with ongoing global trials on HLA tests like HLA-A*31:01, B*15:02, B*57:01, and B*58:01.
- Preventive genetic testing for HLA-B*15:02 is endorsed in national health insurance programs in Taiwan, Singapore, Hong Kong, Thailand, and mainland China for new carbamazepine users. The U.S. FDA recommends HLA-A*31:01 screening before using carbamazepine and HLA-B*15:02 screening before oxcarbazepine, especially for high-risk ethnic groups like Chinese and Thai. An ongoing trial (Identifier: NCT03184597) focuses on HLA screening to reduce adverse drug reactions.
- Genetic HLA-B*57:01 testing before abacavir HIV treatment is widespread and recommended by regulatory agencies but not effective for flucloxacillin due to low predictive value. HLA-
- B*57:03 is linked to DILI from flucloxacillin. The U.S. FDA recommends TPMT and NUDT15 genetic testing before thiopurine use, especially azathioprine. The British Society of Rheumatology advises TPMT testing for Europeans. NUDT15 testing for thiopurine-related leukopenia in Asian populations is being considered for national health insurance support in China and Taiwan but awaits approval

Abstract

Adverse drug reactions (ADRs) remain a significant challenge in healthcare. Severe ADRs, often unpredictable and dose-independent (type B idiosyncratic reactions), have strong links to genetic factors like HLA alleles, drug enzymes, transporters, and T cell receptors. This review summarizes pharmacogenomics in severe ADRs and their clinical potential for prevention.

In the current landscape of research, there is a growing body of literature on genetic variations linked to severe adverse drug reactions (ADR). Advanced technologies like whole genome sequencing (WGS) and whole exome sequencing (WES) have revolutionized the study of genetic biomarkers, enabling quick identification of genetic variants in patients. Pharmacogenetic testing has shown promise both reactively, by explaining or predicting treatment outcomes during drug administration, and preemptively, by preventing severe ADR. Cost-effectiveness studies have supported the use of pharmacogenetic testing, demonstrating that it reduces costs compared to addressing life-threatening ADR. Successful implementation requires standardized processes, expertise, financial support, integrated data systems, and a collaborative team approach. It's crucial to educate physicians in district hospitals and community clinics about genetic testing, as pharmacogenetic testing is poised to play a pivotal role in personalized medicine.
