MEMBERSHIPS REQUIREMENTS OF THE ETHICS COMMITTEE

1. ECs should be multi-disciplinary and multi-sectoral.
2. There should be adequate representation of age and gender.
3. The EC should have a balance between medical and non-medical members/technical and non-technical members, depending upon the needs of the institution.
4. All members will serve for a period of 3 years on renewable basis. New members will be included in the IEC in such a way that there will be a mix of recently included members and members with some years of experience.
5. During the term, Dean of the Faculty in consultation with the Chairman can disqualify any member if, the contribution is not adequate and/or there is long period of non-availability.
6. A member can tender resignation of his office of membership from the IEC to the Dean of Faculty through the Chairperson after serving one-month advance notice.
7. Dean can replace the member of IEC as and when required.
8. Each member is required to sign the declaration and confidentiality agreement regarding IEC activities
9. Conflict of interest should be declared by members of the KLEVKIDS-IEC prior to review meeting.
