



## "Atomic Absorption Spectroscopy –Current Scenario and future prospects"

Date: 21/07/2023 Venue: KAHER's Dr Prabhakar Kore Basic Science Research Centre, Belagavi.

**INTRODUCTION**: Atomic absorption spectrometry (AAS) is a sophisticated, highthroughput, and relatively inexpensive technology used primarily to analyse elements in solution. As such, AAS is used in food and beverage, water, clinical research, and pharmaceutical analysis. It is also used in mining operations to determine, for instance, the percentage of precious metal in ores. AAS analysis helps to overcome challenges such as spectral interference and poor sensitivity associated with other methods addressed. 





The department of CVTS has conducted Foldax Mitral valve wetlab training on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2023. Prof. Dasari Prasada Rao Cardiothoracic surgeon and Chairman, Nano Hospitals Pvt. Ltd., Hyderabad was the resource person.

The Flodax tria is a new generation prosthetic valve made up of polymer (synthetic material) which is produced by USA based company and is on human trial across the world. In India they have selected 10 centres for human trial and KLES Dr. Prabhakar Kore Hospital & MRC, Belagavi is the only centre selected in southern India.

The advantage of this valve claimed by the company is the patient will not require lifelong anticoagulation and antiplatelet drugs. Once the valve is commercially introduced into the market it is going to be a breakthrough technology related to the complications associated with current available prosthetic heart valves.
