PROCEEDINGS OF THE ALLIED COURSES' CO-ORDINATORS MEETING HELD IN THE ACADEMIC COUNCIL OF THE KAHER ON 22-08-2018.

Members present (as per Attendance-sheet):

Dr. V.D.Patil, Registrar welcomed the members.

Hon. Vice-Chancellor briefed the members with the following information:

- The allied health science courses are as important as other regular courses. Allied Health Professionals are the supporting pillars of the health-care team.
- There has been an increasing trend for admissions to various allied courses in the recent past. It is the responsibility of the concerned Dean / Principal / HoD / Course Coordinators to ensure that the allied courses are run successfully.
- The Principals / Heads of the Departments will suggest starting of new academic programs / courses involving inter-disciplinary areas provided they have potential / scope.
- The existing academic programs to which there have been no admissions for the last five years, need to be strengthened by collecting valuable inputs / suggestions from the respective Course Co-ordinators / HoDs. The Principals of the constituent units shall co-ordinate in this regard.
- The respective Principals in consultation with the Course Co-ordinate shall nominate one senior faculty member from the concerned Departments to ensure smooth running of allied courses by every department.
- It was informed that, tutors cannot be appointed as examiners for any of the allied courses. However, Assistant Professors / Lecturers / M.Sc. faculty with Ph.D. degrees with three years teaching experience or faculty members holding an M.Sc. degree with 5 years teaching experience may be recognized as Examiners for allied courses. The same to be placed for consideration in the next meeting of the Academic Council.
- The KAHER has already started a Fellowship Program in Trauma and Emergency Medicine. The Principal, JNMC in consultation with the Heads of the Departments of clinical specialties may identify faculty members who are to be deputed for advanced training in emergency medical services and trauma care so that, their services can be utilized in the Hospital. JNMC may also consider compulsory rotation of faculty members (Associate Professors and above) in the emergency and trauma care section of the Hospital. Dr. M.V.Jali, MD & CE, KLES Dr. P.K. Hospital and MRC, Belagavi shall convene a meeting with the Principal, JNMC and Heads of the Departments of Clinical Specialties and make recommendations to KAHER in this regard.

- The main objective of Fellowship Programs / Certificate courses is to enhance the
 professional skills of doctors, get additional human resource for patient-care and
 increase the visibility of the institution. The Principals and the Heads of the
 Departments need to consider this seriously, in order to get candidates for admission to
 the aforesaid courses.
- In order to create wide publicity for Fellowship / Certificate / PG Diploma programs, the concerned HODs should consider giving advertisements in journals of the concerned specialties about the availability of these courses.
- Dr. Harpreet Kour, Co-ordinator for Allied Courses, JNMC informed that, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has set up National Board for Allied Health Sciences (NBAHS) for ensuring standards and their professional development. NBAHS provides a platform for standardization of courses and curriculum in various health science disciplines. The functional areas of allied health professionals will be divided into three categories viz. diagnostics, technical and therapeutics for separate SOPs as nebtuibed in 'Draft Allied Health-care Professional Central Council Bill-2015' (copy enclosed).
- The Principals and the Course Co-ordinators shall ensure that the syllabi of various allied courses are prepared well-in-advance so that, the same can be made available to the exam section and students.
- Hon. Vice Chancellor, informed the members that labs can be shared between various departments to make optimum use of the available facilities. Principal, JNMC informed that, three demonstration rooms on the 2ndfloor of JNMC have been identified for the purpose of conducting classes for students of allied courses.

The University with a view to widen the scope of admission for Fellowship Programs, it was suggested to consider Diploma in Anaesthesia qualified candidates for admission to Fellowship Program in Trauma and Emergency Medicine. It was decided to place the matter in the forthcoming meeting of the Standing Committee of Academic Council. In order to attract admissions for Fellowship Programs, the University has decided to consider payment of stipend to the candidates who enroll for the same. The University shall write a letter to the MD & CE, KLE Dr. Prabhakar Kore Hospital and MRC, Belagavi requesting to consider payment of stipend to these candidates from the Hospital side which will improve the patient care. It was noted that the University is already paying the stipend amount for some of the Fellowship Programs.

However, while considering the same, the University shall ensure uniformity in the scheme of examination for all such courses.
