### Equipping Tomorrow's Doctors with Soft Skills: What faculty needs to know?"

Skills like Hard and Soft skills are an Integral part of Health Care. 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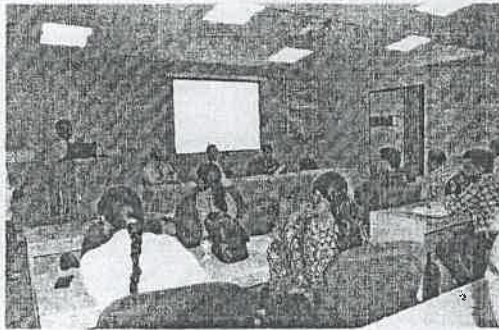
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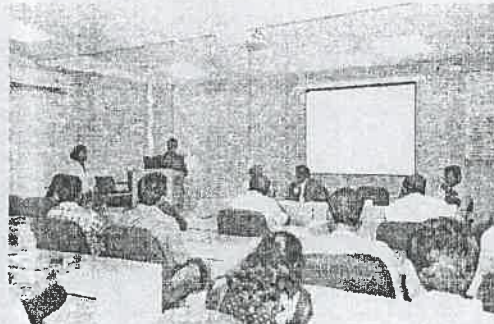

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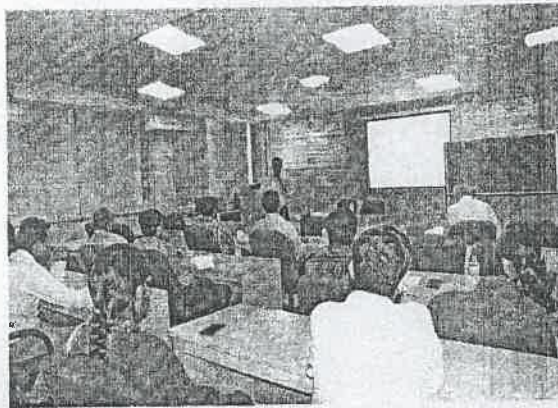
