NOTIFICATION

In accordance with the directives of the Government of Karnataka vide its Order No.RD 158 TNR 2020 dated 16th July 2021 (copy enclosed), it is permitted to **reopen academic institutions pertaining to Health and Medical sector (Medical / Dental Colleges, Colleges and Institutions related to AYUSH, Nursing Colleges and other Allied Health-care academic institutions / colleges, etc.)** with immediate effect.

In pursuance of the same, it has been decided to call back the students on campuses of their respective institutions from **Monday, the 19th July 2021**. **The classes and other academic activities may be resumed from Thursday, the 22nd July 2021**.

The students are hereby informed to rejoin the course / institution by strictly following the guidelines issued by the Government of Karnataka and also submitting the **Certificate in proof of vaccination taken**.

The students are required to strictly adhere to the guidelines, already issued and to be issued from time to time by the Government of India / Government of Karnataka / District Administration / KAHER with regard to precautionary and preventive measures to be taken to curb the spread of COVID-19.

The Principals / Heads of the Institutions are hereby informed to inform the students accordingly.

ORDER

In continuation of the orders of even number dated 03-07-2021 and 08-07-2021 and in exercise of powers conferred under Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Chairman, State Executive Committee, hereby permits re-opening of academic institutions pertaining to Health and Medical sector (Medical/Dental Colleges, Colleges and institutions related to Ayush, Nursing Colleges, and other Allied Health Care academic institutions/colleges, etc) with immediate effect and until further orders strictly adhering to the conditions stipulated as below:

1. Only students, teaching and non-teaching/other staff who have taken at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine will be permitted to attend the aforementioned colleges/institutions.
2. The Colleges and Institutions shall ensure strict adherence to COVID appropriate behaviour and SOPs/guidelines issued by the concerned Department.

Any person violating these measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under Section 188 of the IPC, and other legal provisions as applicable.
