

Conduct of Admission Process for Ph.D. 2020-21 Batch

In view of the COVID pandemic, the Admission Process for Ph.D. 2020-21 Batch will be conducted through **online mode**. This will include a **written test**, which will be **followed by Interview**.

1. The written examination for Ph.D. 2020-21 Batch will be conducted through **Online Mode (Google Forms)**.
2. The **total marks** for the written examination will be **60** and this will include:
 - i. **Section 1:** 15 Multiple Choice Questions (2 marks each) on **Research Methodology**
 - ii. **Section 2:** 3 Short Notes (10 marks each) on their respective **PG Specialty subject**.
3. The duration of the examination will be **1 ½ hours**.
4. All the applicants are required to have an active email id on **gmail.com** to be able to appear for the examination.
5. The date of the written examination is **19th September 2020** from 2.00 pm to 3.30 pm.
6. The Google form for Section 1 will be mailed to individual applicant at 2.00 pm. The applicant has to answer the questions and submit this form latest by 2.30 pm.
7. The Google form for Section 2 will be mailed to individual applicant by 2.15 pm. The applicant has to type the answers for the questions and submit this form latest by 3.30 pm. The answers should be composed by the candidate, as they will be run through plagiarism software. Any malpractice found will disqualify your candidature.
8. Late submission of Google forms will also disqualify the applicant.
9. A **minimum of 35% marks** are to be scored in order **to qualify in the written examination** and to be **eligible for appearing in the interview**.
10. The results of the written examination will be declared by **30th September 2020**.
11. On declaration of the results of the written examination, the successful candidates will have to appear for an **online interview** (schedule for the interview will be intimated to the successful candidates through email; tentative dates for the same will be in the **first week of October 2020**).
12. The overall percentage score for the candidate will be calculated as follows:

a) Marks scored in the Written Examination	= 40%
b) Marks scored in the Post graduate examination	= 40%
c) Marks scored in the Interview	= 20%
13. A **minimum of 55%** overall score will be required for securing admission to the Ph.D. course.
14. The list of candidates selected for Ph.D. course will be uploaded on the university website by **10th October 2020**.
15. The selected candidates will be asked to complete the admission process to the Ph.D. program latest by 6 pm on Saturday, **17th October 2020**.
16. The **Pre-Ph.D. course** will commence **through online mode** from Monday, **19th October 2020**.
